Terms and Conditions

BOOKING

1. A deposit of £50 per person is required at the time of booking for any of the World Class Skiing or BASI Courses. No fees will be charged prior to confirmation of suitable travel arrangements being available to the client. The balance is fully payable 56 days prior to the commencement of the course. In the event of a booking being made within 56 days of the commencement of the Course, the full fee is payable. On receipt of your final invoice, please check that all details are correct and inform us immediately in the event of any discrepancies.

PRICES

2. The prices for the Course events are correct at the time of publication (we reserve the right to modify the prices due to currency fluctuations). All prices for the travel and accommodation are subject to the terms and conditions of your selected tour operator. These do not form any part of your contract with World Class Skiing Ltd.

CANCELLATIONS

3. In the event of a cancellation the following applies to the World Class Skiing elements only:

- > 56 days Full refund of all fees paid
- 43 - 56 days 80% refund of all fees paid
- 29 - 42 days 60% refund of all fees paid
- 15 - 28 days 40% refund of all fees paid
- 8 - 14days 20% refund of all fees paid
- 0 - 7 days No refund available

4. World Class Skiing reserve the right to cancel a showcase or BASI Course up to 57 days prior to the date of the event. A full refund of all fees directly for the events will be paid. In the unlikely event of World Class Skiing cancelling an event within 56 days or less, a full refund of all fees paid directly for the World Class Skiing element will be refunded in full.

BASI COURSES

5. World Class Skiing require a minimum of 8 people attending a BASI course. If the required numbers are not reached the course will be cancelled and you will be notified 7 days of the start date, and all payments will be refunded.

6. BASI require that your skiing should be at a suitable standard and we strongly recommend you make yourself familiar with this standard required by visiting the BASI website. www.basi.org.uk

7. World Class Skiing cannot be held responsible for 3rd party failures regarding the venue. This includes, lift malfunction, surface quality, health and safety issues etc. (This list is NOT exhaustive.) These remain the responsibility of the slope operator. Where a course is clearly unable to be carried out, World Class Skiing will, as a goodwill gesture, endeavour to re-arrange a further session. This will be discussed at the time.

8. World Class Skiing cannot be held responsible for equipment owned by the client or loaned by the slope operator. It is YOUR responsibility to ensure all equipment and clothing is safe and appropriate.

WORLD CLASS SKIING EVENT INFORMATION

DURATION

9. For events held over a 5-day period, you will receive a minimum of 15 hours instruction and up to 25 hours where conditions and the number of World Class Ski teachers allow.

10. For events held over a 10-day period, you will receive a minimum of 30 hours instruction and up to 50 hours where conditions and the number of World Class Ski teachers allow.

CLASS SIZES

11. A class will not exceed 10 except due to exceptional circumstances. The average group size last season was 8.

12. Where one World Class Ski teacher is hosting the week, the group may be split into two equal sessions to accommodate the differences in standard. In this event you will be offered alternate AM and PM sessions.

PRIVATE HIRE

13. The client is responsible for the cost of travel and accommodation of the World Class Ski Teacher (WCST) that will be charged at cost in addition to the fees published on the Private Hire page. The WCST can travel with your party or separately.

14. Accommodation for the WCST will be a minimum of 3* quality or equivalent and will be on a Half Board (HB) basis. In the event of HB not being available, a meal allowance of £25 per day will be charged.

CLASS LEVELS

15. World Class Skiing will endeavour to ensure that you are skiing at a level where you can relax, excel and enjoy the experience. This may occasionally mean that you are in a different group from a friend or partner. If you specifically wish to ski with a fellow traveller, we will try and accommodate your request. In this event, the selected group for both parties will be at the slower pace.

WEATHER

16. Due to the nature of a mountain environment there may be occasions where the weather conditions may prevent the course running for a period. Where possible, this time will be made up at the discretion of the World Class Skiing teacher.

SNOW CONDITIONS

17. Our resorts have been chosen for their suitability to host World Class Skiing events. While snow conditions may vary we will endeavour to use our skill and experience to continue within the prevailing conditions.

INSURANCE

18. All clients are responsible for their own travel insurance that must include Wintersports cover. You will be requested to provide evidence of possession of a valid policy prior to commencement of the event.
